A Half Fold leaflet is a simple and effective way to present information. This fold divides a sheet into two equal halves, creating four panels. Here's how it works:

Layout Description

1. Outer Panels:

- o **Front 1**: This is the front cover of the leaflet, designed to grab attention.
- Front 4: This is the back cover, typically used for contact details or additional information.

2. Inner Panels:

- o **Inside 2**: The left inner panel, often used to introduce the main content or message.
- Inside 3: The right inner panel, used to expand on the content or include supporting details.

- Balance the content between Inside 2 and Inside 3 to maintain visual harmony.
